Complexion

1. **Kiko Milano Colour Correct Concealer** — my secret weapon: the green covers any bright red spots you might get really well, so that you can wear a lot less foundation, the orangey/reddish shades are great at canceling out under-eye darkness, the highlighter shade makes red marks disappear when combined with your concealer.
2. Discontinued Benefit Boi-ing Industrial Strength Concealer. I've used this product since high school, and I'm really sad they decided to stop making it. However, I have enough left for at least two years... :)
3. **Jane Iredale Pure Pressed Powder Base** — I've converted THOUSANDS of women to this mineral powder foundation and I don't work for the brand. It's my fave pressed mineral foundation and I've worn it since I was around 20 yrs old. It has buildable coverage, doesn't clog pores, looks natural throughout the day, polished, doesn't look cakey, and isn't drying. My color is Warm Silk. [You can hear me talk more about it here!](#)
4. **Charlotte Tilbury Bronze & Glow** — very neutral and natural shades that don't look too orange on cool-toned skin
5. **Dior Rosey Glow Blush** — 001 Pink, but other colors are great too!
6. **Jane Iredale Blush** — these used to be the best, but they've changed the formulas and the colors, and *are no longer recommended*
7. **Mac Cosmetics Extra-Dimension Blush** — very pretty, **dupe**

Eyes

1. **Mac Cosmetics Eyeshadows** — I've used these eyeshadows since I first started wearing makeup. And they continue to be my fave brand for eyeshadows with an incredible collection of colors and **palettes you can customize**.

Colours in video:

Malt (soft pinkish/greyish-beige)

Woodwinked (dark gold)

Antiqued (bronzey brown)

Coquette (perfect dark blonde)

2. **Kiko Milano Eyeshadow Stick** — These last all day, don't budge on oily eyelids, and offer a pretty nice selection of colours. I mostly use them for lining my eyes.

Colours in video:

20 Dark Taupe

38 discontinued (looks a lot like Mac's Satin Taupe Eyeshadow)

02 Rose

3. **Laura Mercier Caviar Shadow Stick** — This brand has the prettiest eyeshadow stick colours in my opinion. I wore Bed Of Roses (discontinued) in this video, but Strike A Rose is similar.

4. **Catrice Glam & Doll Easy Wash Off Mascara** — I love a my-lashes-but-better look out of my mascara, and this one does just that with a bit of volume and length. It's a tubing technology, very easy to apply, and the best part is that it's beyond easy to remove at the end of the day. It's been my go-to for years now (*oh and the price is insane*).

Lips

1. **Kevyn Aucoin Unforgettable Lip Definer** — A very neutral brown in Divine that contours the lips in a very natural way.
2. Mac Cosmetics Lipstick — Syrup, bad news: it appears to be discontinued. Unfortunately I have only one of these and this shade is incredibly difficult to find because it is a true cool pink that does not lean warm at all (like most fugly shades on the market do!!).
3. Maybelline Lipstick — That's Mauvie, bad news: it appears to be discontinued AGAIN...Luckily I have literally enough backups to last a decade.
4. Bonus: **Maybelline Lifter Gloss** — since the last two were discontinued, I included my fave ever sparkly gloss that always makes me feel extra good-looking lol. My colour is Silk, it's sparkly in an expensive looking way!
